3. Matters Arising:

Bar Facilities : Awaiting confirmation details from the Council regarding licensing regulations.

Curling Session Times: to remain the same as last session (6.30 & 8.30pm) with discussions with all Clubs to determine their views throughout the year.

RCCC: news coming in that Dumfries may be hosting the Scottish Mens Competition, further details awaited.

4. Finance Update:

Alex Dickson is to contact Rosemary Lenton regarding assistance from the subgroup to assist with addressing various aspects including the curling sponsorship boards in the halls where the sponsorship has expired. The levy update is carried forward to the next meeting.

5. Facility Update:

Alex Dickson is to approach the facility over various queries which need clarification including :

The possibility of increasing the number of user group meetings with the facility to improve communications – at present there are only two meetings.

Parking arrangements during the time that the pool is in situ on the carpark – how will it be managed, will staff parking be off site?, so that curlers can be circulated with information in advance of the new season.

The February 2015 ice skating competition – could curling sessions still be held in the evening? What are the competition times to be?

The presentation of the curling hall could be improved before the new session – the Committee were willing to assist the facility address this both in identifying the shortfalls and to remedy them. How does the facility feel about this?

6. Sub Committee Updates :

Competitions: Graham, David and Michael have provided provisional ice guidelines, it is an enormous task to allocate the ice effectively and work is ongoing.

Communications: Mike is communicating with clubs and club secretaries to assist with updating databases and to build on communications. The member's handbook is to be updated and issued when a member's levy is paid. An open invitation was extended to all to the Communication sub group meetings.

RCCC: no update available.

AOCB:

Graham Sloan commented that the Cairn Club has its 150th Anniversary this year and is to celebrate by having a one day Bonspiel in November, already with a good response. It is to be a full day event including a meal — support was recommended for them as it is a good achievement — maybe newspaper coverage and money for prizes.
