Holiday Inn

A comfortable Dumfries hotel next to Easterbrook Hall, with an all-day restaurant and a lounge bar. Holiday Inn Dumfries hotel places you a 10-minute drive from the market town of Dumfries. In the town centre, Dumfries station is served by direct trains to Carlisle and Glasgow. The hotel offers complimentary parking and is within easy reach of the A75 road, leading to the A74(M) motorway.

Business travellers can host meetings for up to 80 delegates in 3 flexible meeting rooms, while major events and conferences at Easterbrook Hall are right on the hotel's doorstep. A short walk away, Crichton Golf Club is the closest of many courses in the area. In Dumfries, a short drive from the hotel, the Robert Burns Centre Film Theatre displays the poet's original manuscripts, as well as screening the latest cinema releases. The ruins of medieval Sweetheart Abbey are only 8 miles away, and a 30-minute drive takes you to rambling or mountain biking trails through the Forest of Ae.

The hotel's bright restaurant, The Bankend Bar & Brasserie, serves a hot buffet breakfast, as well as lunch and dinner prepared from locally sourced produce. In the evening, relax in an armchair in the glass-ceilinged lounge bar with a cocktail or a dram from our whisky collection.

Rivendell Guest House

This attractive 19th century property offers luxury B&B accommodation and a prime location just a short walk away from Dumfries's town centre. The Charles Rennie Mackintosh-inspired mansion has been beautifully restored and a great deal of care has been taken to ensure the elegant property maintains its original character and charm. Each of the large, luxurious en suite bedrooms is beautifully decorated and furnished to the highest of standards, with genuine antiques in-keeping with the age and style of the house where possible. The comfy king-size beds, with their crisp white sheets and quality bedding, guarantee a good night's sleep. In addition, a TV, tea and coffee facilities and lots of other home comforts are provided which will make your stay a perfect one.

Hamilton House Dumfries

This establishment has received its official star rating from VisitScotland, the National Tourist Board for Scotland. Free self parking is available onsite. Stay in one of 7 guestrooms featuring LCD televisions. Digital television is provided for your entertainment. Bathrooms have showers and hair dryers. Conveniences include desks and coffee/tea makers. Cairndale Hotel

Conveniently located in the heart of Dumfries with 91 ensuite rooms and suites. The Cairndale Hotel & Leisure Club is one of Dumfries & Galloway's largest privately owned hotels. The facility is a two-minute walk from the central railway station and is a five-minute stroll from the main shopping area of the town. The hotel sits adjacent to the DG One Leisure complex and is a short walkable distance from the other main leisure facilities at Dumfries Ice Bowl where the Curling Championship will take place.

Dumfries and Galloway is located in the Southwest of Scotland. The Region is rural but has various airports and train stations for visiting teams to enter into the Region.

Trains

Dumfries and Galloway has both local and national rail connections. The train station is in the heart of the town and a short walk from two of the chosen accommodation providers. If competitors choose to travel by train the OC shall arrange for collection from the train stations at either Dumfries or Lockerbie and transfer to the accommodation provider. Utilising the train system will provide competitors with the most relaxing transfer to Dumfries and allow visitors to view our spectacular country.

Transport & around the town

Our accommodation providers have been selected due to their proximity to the curling venue. The OC feel this will provide competitors and spectators with the best opportunities to explore by foot the delight of the town. Public transport is excellent around the town.

Air

Dumfries is within easy reach of a number of airports, both in England and Scotland. Glasgow, Manchester and Newcastle are all international airports with a wide range of destinations, while others serve a more limited number of destinations, but offer budget flights.
