How it Works?

Teams: Each team consists of four players: Lead, Second, Third (or Vice-Skip), and Skip.

Ends: A game is made up of “ends,” similar to innings in baseball. In each end, teams take turns sliding eight stones each (two per player).

Scoring: Points are scored based on how many stones are closer to the centre of the house than the nearest opponent’s stone.

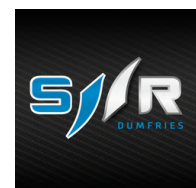
